PLAY WITH BRAIN - PSYCHODRAMA WITH GIFTED CHILDREN

- workshop -

Gifted children develop asynchronously, are advanced from the cognitive point of view, but at or below their age emotionally and socially. Playing with gifted children can be different and challenging due to this pattern of development, which creates the need to adapt the psychodrama in order to cover the complexities in both the process and the content of the therapeutic work.

In our workshop we will explain how therapists can identify the traits of gifted children, allowing them to adapt the interventions accordingly. We will explore what are the main factors to be considered when playing with gifted children that can make the therapeutic work a lot more challenging and frustrating, how superior cognitive development and a high ability to think abstractly influence the scenarios the children generate and how a therapist can keep up with the multifaceted emotional themes, advanced moral dilemmas or abstract concepts the children bring up in a psychodrama session.

Participants will have the opportunity to experiment with specific interventions that address the higher emotional sensitivity of gifted children, which sometimes manifests dramatically and very intensely, creating more vulnerability and thus making the therapeutic process more challenging to navigate effectively. They will learn how to help these children feel safe and how to encourage them to feel the joy of playing without the questioning and analyzing that a gifted mind does.
